Religious minorities and non-religious students experience campus differently than Christian students. Minority and non-religious students report more:



Negative interactions with peers of other worldviews



Conflict between groups on campus



Feelings of coercion on campus

is a theoretically-based and empirically-validated assessment tool designed to assist campus leaders in creating climates that embrace the challenges and realize the possibilities of supporting diverse religious and non-religious students on campus.

Developed by Dr. Alyssa Bryant Rockenbach (North Carolina State University) and Dr. Matthew Mayhew (New York University), the CRSCS is administered in partnership with Interfaith Youth Core (www.ifyc.org) and Campus Labs (campuslabs.com).
